REMINDERS FROM YOUR TRASH MAN.....

Regular trash service includes:

- Weekly collection of unlimited household trash put in **plastic bags ONLY. DO NOT USE REFILLABLE TRASH CONTAINERS OF ANY SORT!**
- 15 bags of yard waste (LEAVES AND GRASS.)
- 10 bundles of tree limbs (4 ft. length x 2 ft. in diameter.)
- Weight limit is 40 lbs. on bags of waste.
- Please bag ALL animal waste.
- **WE CANNOT ACCEPT** any liquid waste such as oil, paint, chemicals, etc. or batteries.
- Please have trash curb side by 7 a.m. on day of collection. OUR DAY IS TUESDAY.

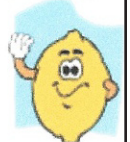
