If you like the outdoors and enjoy walking, there is nothing that will stimulate your senses more than a walk around Wolhurst Lake. This hike, which is about a mile in length, takes you on a trail winding through the woods and through areas where at times interesting species of four-legged critters can be seen. You can get real close to nature here. At times, we have deer, raccoons, foxes, and coyotes besides rabbits and squirrels.

And if you have a small boat you can exercise your arms while rowing around the lake. Some folks have paddle boats and use their legs instead.



Of course during the summer the one place where you might want to be is in the swimming pool. It opens in the early summer as soon as the weather permits, and stays open till some time in the fall as long as the warm weather allows. An hour is set aside a few mornings each week for an exercise class. Whether you like to splash or crash, this is the place to be when the sun gets hot.



Try out our exercise room. If you're into exercise machines and are looking for a certain type of machine, the chances are you will find it here. Our exercise room is equipped with a variety of equipment, such as bicycles, treadmills, weights, and a host of other types of equipment.



Do you have a flair for the artistic? Join the folks in the Ceramics Room and see what beautiful things you can make. Our Ceramics Room has just been remodeled, repainted, and set with new lighting. It is a wonderful place to create something with your own hands. And there are folks who will give instruction and help if you are new at it.



Many residents are unaware of our woodworking shop in the basement of the Clubhouse. If you are into this type of work or hobby this room is available to you. There are many pieces of equipment such as table saws, belt sander, router, jointer, sabre saw, drill press, planer, grinders, band saw and other equipment.



If you have your own computer, or if you don't and you would like to learn to be a computer person, we have facilities available here. We offer a fully equipped Computer Room, with ten computers already hooked to Qwest Internet High Speed. And our Computer Club offers instruction and coaching to those who request it.



Your liking may be for some of the indoor activities such as pool or ping-pong. These activities are located in the Clubhouse and are available to all residents
